

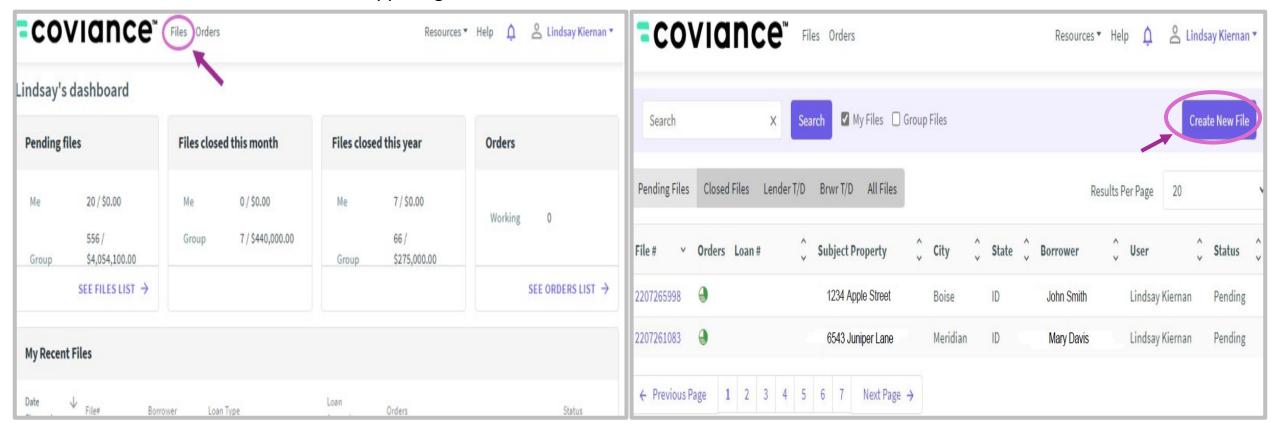
HELOC Ordering Guide through



Ordering HVE (Home Value Explorer)

The HVE or AVM (Automated Valuation Model) serves as a desktop appraisal, replacing the need for a traditional appraisal. If the HVE indicates insufficient equity to proceed with a HELOC and the member requests that we order a full appraisal, the cost will be the member's responsibility. The appraisal fee must be collected before ordering the full appraisal.

- Log in to Coviance
- Click on Files in the upper left corner (This will bring up your HELOC files keyed in Coviance)
- Click on Create New File in the upper right corner

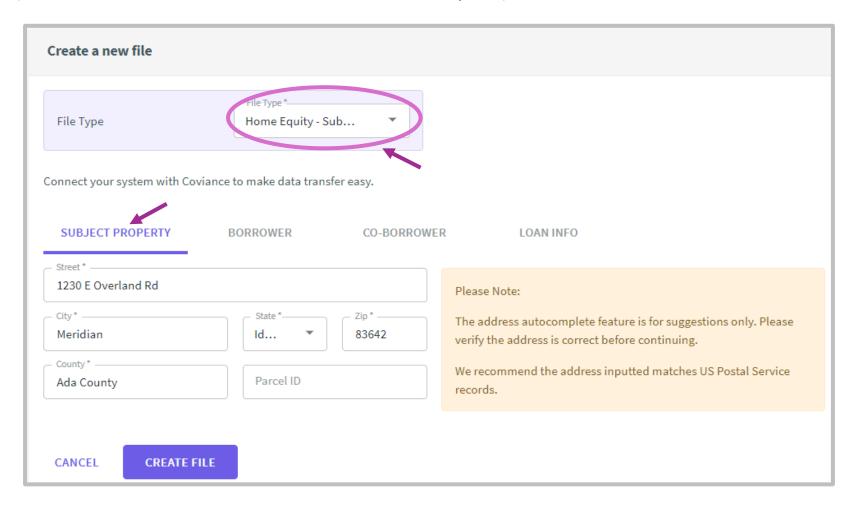


File Type

• Under File Type, select either Home Equity- 1st Lien (if in first lienholder position) or Home Equity- Subordinate Lien (if in second lienholder position)

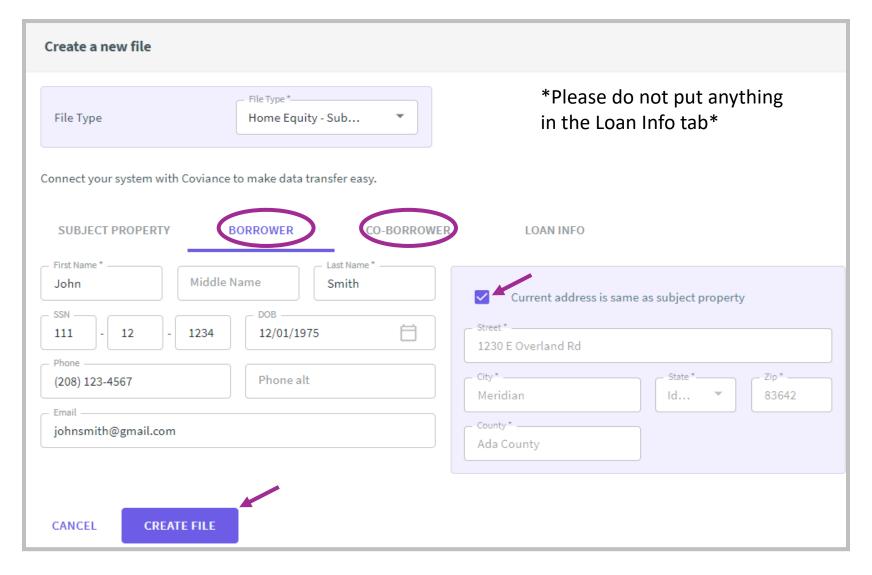
Subject Property

Fill in address (Make sure the address is correct as it will autocomplete)

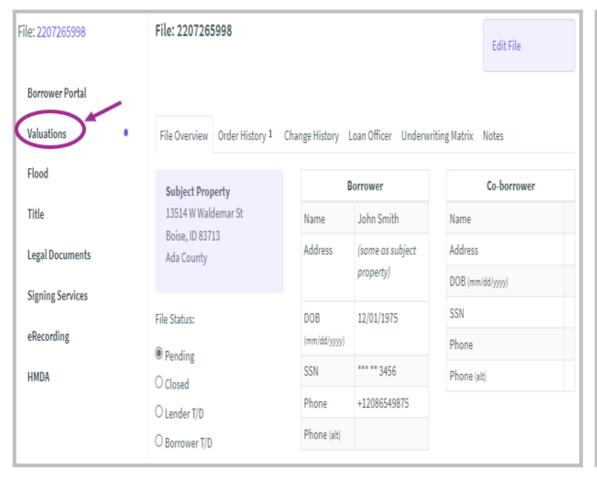


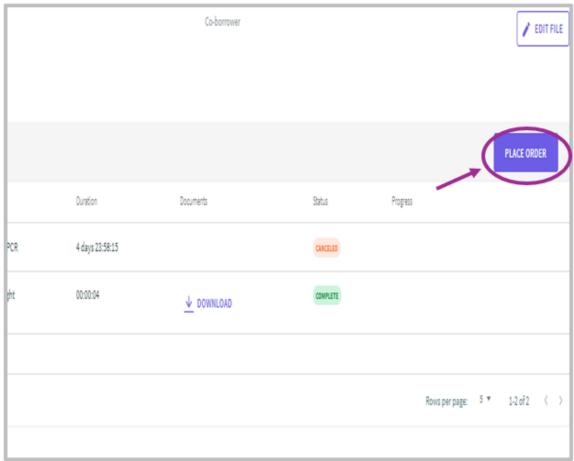
Borrower and Coborrower

• Fill in all information for the borrower and/or co-borrower (check the box stating the address is the same as the subject property)

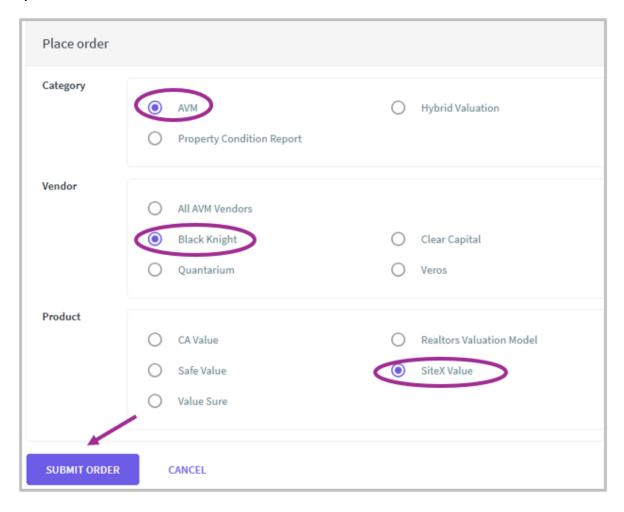


- Click on Valuations in the upper left corner
- Click on Place Order in the upper right corner

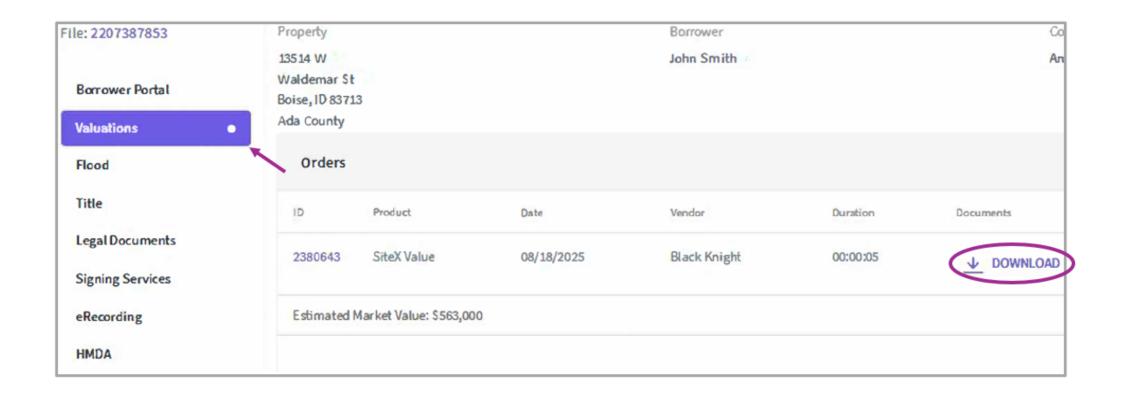




- Category is AVM
- Vendor is Black Knight
- Product is SiteX Value (If you receive the response of "no hit" you can use All AVM Vendors). No-hit means the specified vendor was not able to pull a valuation on the address entered.



- Click on Valuations in upper left corner
- Download HVE



Ordering PCR (Property Condition Report)

The property condition report provides a detailed understanding of the external property's conditions. This includes images, descriptions, and a record of any existing damage to the property. This is used in conjunction with the desktop appraisal to determine the estimated property value without completing a full appraisal.

There are two ways to obtain the Property Condition Report:

Borrower Portal (Borrower led photos –Preferred by CCU)

OR

2. Coviance PCR (Ordered through Coviance)

Borrower Portal (Borrower Led Photos/Virtual PCR)

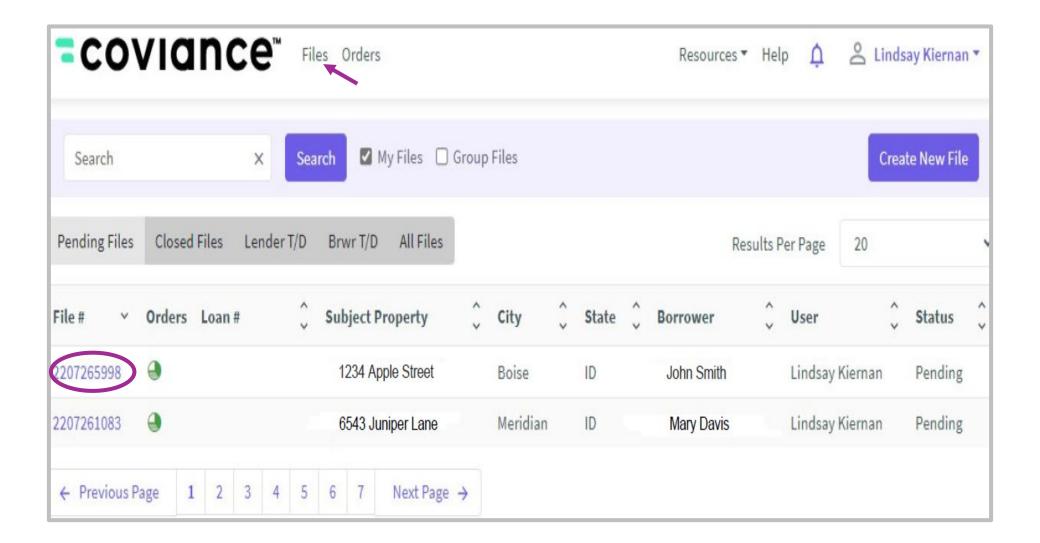

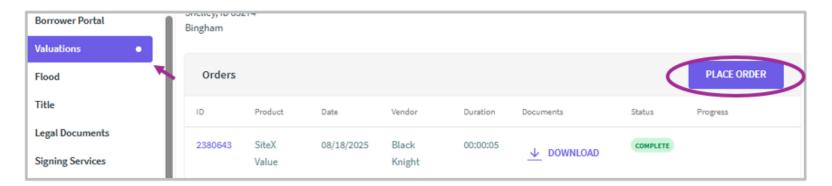

Coviance PCR

- Click on Files in the upper left corner (This will bring up your HELOC files keyed in Coviance)
- Click on the File Number

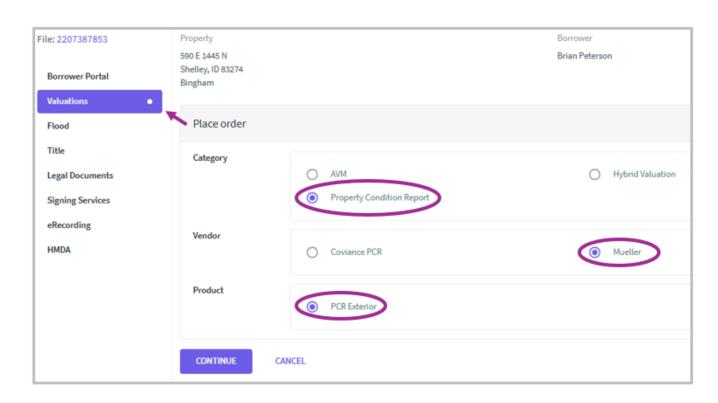


• Click on Valuations in the upper left corner and then Place Order

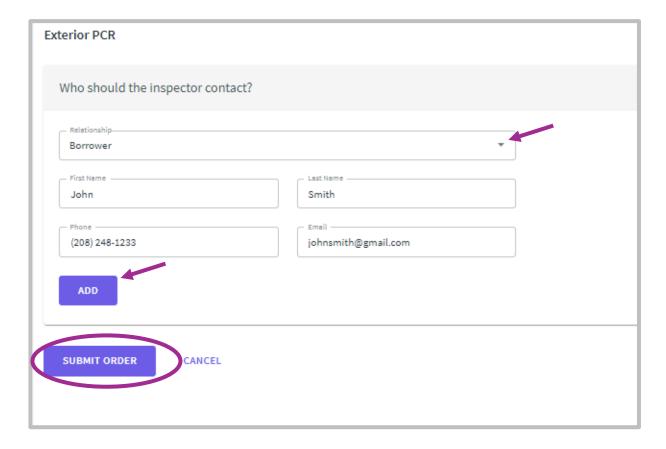


- Category is Property Condition Report
- Vendor is Mueller PCR
- Product is Exterior PCR

After you order the PCR, if the status says "prepared" for more than two days reach out to Coviance <u>support</u> for an update.



• Use the drop-down menu to select borrower, click Add and then Submit Order



• Coviance will send you an email when the PCR is completed. This email needs to be forwarded to indirect@connectidaho.org. The Indirect department will provide the Property Valuation Review Form.

Ordering Flood Report

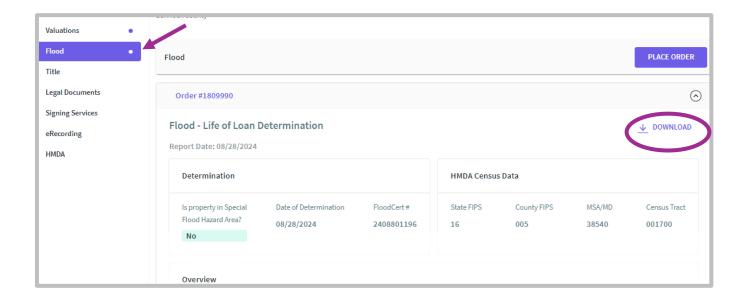
(Modification to Deed of Trust do NOT require a new Flood Report)

A flood certificate serves to identify whether a property is located in a flood zone, helping determine if flood insurance is required. It provides critical information about potential flood risks, ensuring proper insurance coverage and compliance with federal regulations.

- Click on Flood in the upper left corner
- Click Place Order

- Download Flood Certification
